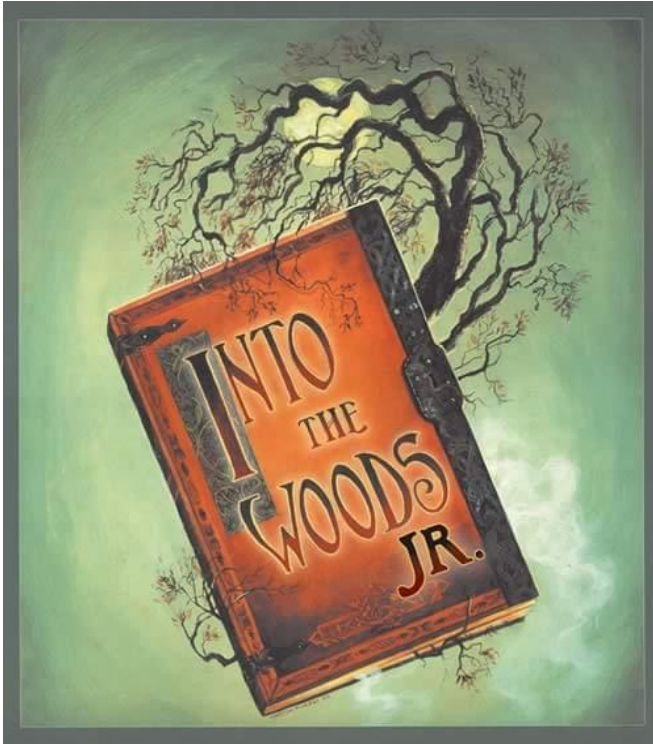

EGMS/HS shows she has been involved with include *Disney's Beauty & the Beast*, *Schoolhouse Rock Live!*, *The Music of Glee*, *Sing Off*, *Bye Bye Birdie*, *Peter Pan, Jr.*, *Cabaret Night 2015*, *Camp Rock*, *Once on this Island (still the favorite)*, *9-5 The Musical*, *Sister Act*, *Matilda*, *Freaky Friday*, *Legally Blonde, Jr.*, and now *Into the Woods Jr.* This show has involved the most cooperative cast ever! Stef has been privileged to work with the summer theater programs in E.G. in the past, as well. Stefanie has been dancing, instructing, and choreographing for over 25 years. 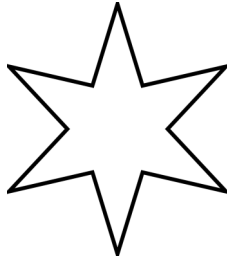

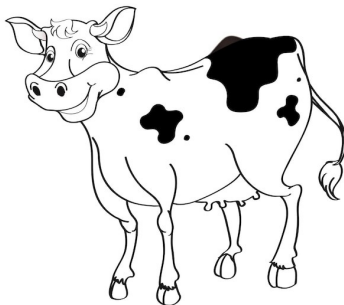

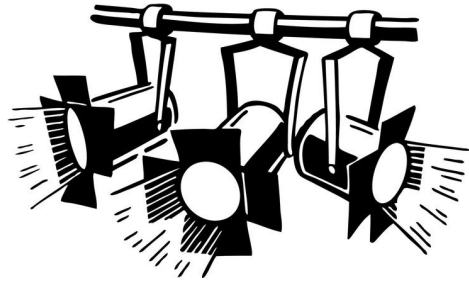
